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Returned Students and the Disciplinary Foundation of Modern Chinese Literature

Abstract: The discipline of modern Chinese literature is a product of the transition from traditional Chinese literary discipline to modern discipline. The disciplinary foundation began in the late 1920s and completed in the early 1930s with the basic theory, educational system and research system.
