# Three Approaches to Heidegger's Nihilistic Philosophy of Being

**Abstract:** Heidegger's elucidation of the meaning of nothingness- being is particularly revealed as the following three approaches. The first is based on ontological difference, considering nihilism as the immediate consequence of the oblivion of being and thus converting existentialism to linguistic ontology. The second approach is from describing desertion of being to revealing the existential nature of nothingness. The third approach is a return to nothingness- being. The above three approaches connect the sources of being and the self-consciousness of Ereignis, constituting Heidegger's nihilistic philosophy of being.
